



Instructions for abstracts

You: (name, place of work, email address)

Title: (maximum one line, e.g. gender, age and major findings, <u>without</u> patient's name or date of birth)

History, investigations, and major findings: focus on <u>abnormal</u> findings, do not reveal the diagnosis.

Diagnosis: Known or unknown (if the diagnosis is known, do <u>not</u> reveal it in the abstract!)

Maximum length 1/2 page. Be concise.

Deadline for abstract submission is Monday August 12th, 2024.

We will send you a confirmation email when we have received your abstract(s). Please bring your presentation(s) Tuesday August 27th as a PowerPoint file. When presenting:

- Start with a photograph of the patient while you very <u>briefly</u> present the history and major findings. The best presentations are those with few slides (3-4), each of which includes a good patient photograph and a summary of significant findings.
- Show the best picture of your patient on the last slide with a concise summary.
- If the diagnosis is known, reveal it <u>after</u> the audience has had a chance to make suggestions.

Depending on the number of cases, we will have 5-10 minutes for each including time for discussion.

Because the meeting is based the exchange of knowledge among participants, your case presentations "make the meeting".
